### Tradition 8

**Alcoholics Anonymous should remain forever nonprofessional, but our service centers may employ special workers.**

"Because it has now become plain enough that **only** a recovered alcoholic can do much for a sick alcoholic, a tremendous responsibility has descended upon us all, an obligation so great that it amounts to a sacred trust." Bill W, 1948 letter to the Grapevine.

Tradition Eight, the long version, tells us "... we may employ alcoholics ...to perform those services for which we might otherwise have to engage nonalcoholics." Our staff at SRI's central office come to work every day to coordinate, organize and facilitate the operations of that office. They manage sales, input information, provide records, inventory literature, order supplies and equipment, enable special events and phone answering, and much more. They need not be alcoholics to perform these important functions. Many non-alcoholics are capable office managers, data entry personnel, etc. I enjoy pitching in for an hour or two on occasion. But every day? Without pay? So, our staff is paid to provide daily support to over 300 groups so that recovered alcoholics in the Phoenix, Scottsdale & Tempe areas can carry a message that "can do much for a sick alcoholic."

Well, why not me? I spend much of my time helping sponsees through their Steps; being available to make and take calls; helping people move, driving them to meetings or to get groceries, caring for their pets when they're gone; meeting for lunch or coffee. I listen to newcomers when friends and family won't. I hear them when no one outside of AA can. I speak with them in ways they understand.

I came to AA years ago, begging to have the obsession and compulsion to drink alcohol removed. It was removed. I was paid in full. Loving sponsors walked me through the life-changing Steps, and guided me on a path to "release from care, worry and boredom." I was paid in full. My life today is full of fellowship and purpose. I carry "a sacred trust" that was freely given to me. I give it freely to others because I have already been paid in full.

### Concept 8

*The Trustees of the General Service Board act in two primary capacities: (a) With respect to the larger matters of over-all policy and finance, they are the principal planners and administrators. They and their primary committees directly manage these affairs. (b) But with respect to our separately incorporated and constantly active services, the relation of the Trustees is mainly that of full stock ownership and of custodial oversight which they exercise through their ability to elect all directors of these entities.*

Concept 8 addresses the potential dangers of too few people taking on too many tasks. Bill W. warned against "too much concentration of money and authority," based on early AA experiences.

The General Service Board is not directly involved in the daily operations of the General Service Office or AA publications. Instead, those tasks are delegated to others, such as the office manager. This allows the Board to focus on larger questions of policy, finance, group relations and leadership. Taken from the 2020 Filing Cabinet

- see that all decisions and resolutions of the Steering Committee and Intergroup are carried out;
- execute, in the name of the Intergroup, all contracts and other documents affecting the Intergroup with of approval of a quorum of the Steering Committee and/or the Intergroup via email or monthly meeting;
- appoint, subject to the confirmation of the Steering Committee at the next regularly scheduled Steering Committee meeting, all Event Chairpersons, and all Chairpersons of Standing Committees;
- create ad hoc committees to carry out special projects of a short term nature, and may appoint, subject to the confirmation of the Steering committee, the Chairpersons of such committees;
- be the spokesperson for the Intergroup in all public matters and issues;
- has general oversight responsibility for the proper and effective conduct of all committees, and may recommend removal of any Chairperson from any Committee or Event to the Steering Committee; and,
- Appoint a Parliamentarian for the Intergroup meeting in the absence of the Immediate Past Chairperson.

Vice-Chairperson: Five (5) years of continuous sobriety. Term is 1 year.

- chair the Steering Committee meetings and Intergroup meetings in the absence of the Chairperson;
- serve as the Liaison to the Area Assemblies; and,
- Perform such other duties as may from time to time be prescribed by the Chairperson or the Steering Committee.

Secretary: Three (3) years of continuous sobriety. Term is 2 years.

- keep and publish the minutes of all Steering Committee and Intergroup meetings;
- perform all other duties appropriate to the position of a corporate secretary, and such other duties as may be prescribed from time to time by the Chairperson or the Steering Committee; and,
- act as presiding Chairperson of any Steering Committee or Intergroup meetings in the absence of the Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson and Treasurer.

Advisor: Three (3) years of continuous sobriety. Term is 2 years.

- attend and participate in Steering Committee meetings;
- attend the Intergroup meetings; and,
- perform such other duties as may be prescribed from time to time by the Chairperson or Steering Committee.

In order for an Intergroup rep to vote in the November elections they, or their substitute, must attend 3 out of 5 Intergroup meetings starting in June through October.
